

END USER LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR MSI SOFTWARE

IMPORTANT — READ CAREFULLY:

This End-User License Agreement (“EULA”) is a legal agreement between you (either an individual or a single entity) (“Licensee”) and MSI Software Solutions, LLC, a North Carolina limited liability company (“MSI”) for the MSI software that accompanies this EULA, which includes computer software and may include associated media, printed materials, online or electronic documentation, and Internet-based services (collectively “Software”). An amendment or addendum to this EULA may accompany the Software.

YOU AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THE TERMS OF THIS EULA BY INSTALLING, COPYING, OR OTHERWISE USING THE SOFTWARE. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE, DO NOT INSTALL, COPY, OR USE THE SOFTWARE; YOU MAY RETURN IT TO YOUR PLACE OF PURCHASE (IF APPLICABLE) FOR A FULL REFUND.

MSI SOFTWARE LICENSE

1. **GRANTS OF LICENSE.** MSI grants you the rights described in this EULA provided that you comply with all terms and conditions of this EULA.

1.1 **General License Grant.** MSI grants to you as an individual, a personal, nonexclusive license to use the Software, and to make and use copies of the Software for the purposes of designing, developing, testing, and demonstrating your software product(s), provided that you are the only individual using the Software. If you are an entity, MSI grants to you a personal, nonexclusive license to use the Software, and to make and use copies of the Software, provided that for each individual using the Software within your organization, you have acquired a separate and valid license for each such individual.

1.2 **Documentation.** You may make and use an unlimited number of copies of any documentation, provided that such copies shall be used only for personal purposes and are not to be republished or distributed (either in hard copy or electronic form) beyond your premises.

1.3 **Storage/Network Use.** You may also store or install a copy of the Software on a storage device, such as a network server, used only to install or run the Software on computers used by licensed end users in accordance with Section 1.1. A single license for the Software may not be shared or used concurrently by multiple end users.

2. **RESERVATION OF RIGHTS AND OWNERSHIP.** The Software is protected by copyright and other intellectual property laws and treaties. North Carolina State University (“NCSU”) owns the original title, copyright, and other intellectual property rights in the Software (“Original Software”) and MSI owns the copyright and other intellectual property on the derivative works. MSI has an exclusive sub-licensable license to the

Software. The Software is licensed, not sold. MSI reserves all rights not expressly granted to you or NCSU in this EULA.

3. **LIMITATIONS ON REVERSE ENGINEERING, DECOMPIATION, AND DISASSEMBLY.** You may not reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the Software, except and only to the extent that such activity is expressly permitted by applicable law notwithstanding this limitation.

4. **NO RENTAL/COMMERCIAL HOSTING.** You may not rent, lease, lend, or provide commercial hosting services for, the Software.

5. **CONSENT TO USE OF DATA.** You agree that MSI and its affiliates may collect and use technical information gathered as part of the product support services provided to you, if any, related to the Software. MSI may use this information solely to improve our products or to provide customized services or technologies to you and will not disclose this information in a form that personally identifies you.

6. **LINKS TO THIRD PARTY SITES.** You may link to third party sites through the use of the Software. The third party sites are not under the control of MSI, and MSI is not responsible for the contents of any third party sites, any links contained in third party sites, or any changes or updates to third party sites. MSI is not responsible for webcasting or any other form of transmission received from any third party sites. MSI is providing these links to third party sites to you only as a convenience, and the inclusion of any link does not imply an endorsement by MSI of the third party site.

7. **ADDITIONAL SOFTWARE/SERVICES.** This EULA applies to updates, supplements, add-on components, or Internet-based services components, of the Software that MSI may provide to you or make available to you after the date you obtain your initial copy of the Software, unless we provide other terms along with the update, supplement, add-on component, or Internet-based services component. MSI reserves the right to discontinue any Internet-based services provided to you or made available to you through the use of the Software.

8. **UPGRADES/DOWNGRADES.**

8.1 **Upgrades.** To use a version of the Software identified as an upgrade, you must first be licensed for the software identified by MSI as eligible for the upgrade. After upgrading, you may no longer use the software that formed the basis for your upgrade eligibility, and your use of the Software shall be governed by the EULA associated with the upgraded Software.

8.2 **Downgrades.** Instead of installing and using the Software, you may install and use copies of an earlier version of the Software, provided that you completely remove such earlier version and install the current version of the Software within a reasonable time. Your use of such earlier version shall be governed by this EULA, and your rights to use such earlier version shall terminate when you install the Software.

9. **NOT FOR RESALE SOFTWARE.** The Software is identified as “Not For Resale” or “NFR”; you may not sell, license, lease, distribute, publish, or otherwise transfer the Software to any other party .

10. **EXPORT RESTRICTIONS.** You acknowledge that the Software is subject to U.S. export jurisdiction. You agree to comply with all applicable international and national laws that apply to the Software, including the U.S. Export Administration Regulations, as well as end-user, enduse, and destination restrictions issued by U.S. and other governments.

11. **PROHIBITION ON SOFTWARE TRANSFER.** You may not transfer this EULA or Software to any other party. You may not sublicense the Software in any way.

12. **TERMINATION.** Without prejudice to any other rights, MSI may terminate this EULA if you fail to comply with the terms and conditions of this EULA. In such event, you must destroy all copies of the Software and all of its component parts. Unless otherwise agreed by the end-user and MSI, the license to use the Software shall automatically terminate at the end of 12 months after license purchase. When the end user’s license expires, is revoked, and/or terminated, the user may no longer use the Software on any computer.

13. **LIMITED WARRANTY.** Except for the “Redistributables,” which are provided AS IS without warranty of any kind, MSI warrants that the Software will perform substantially in accordance with the accompanying materials during the 15-day trial period. During the trial period, the end user should fully test the Software and ensure that it fits their needs and at their own risk. The end user should report any issues to MSI directly such that MSI can determine the root cause(s) of any reported defects. While MSI will attempt to repair reported defects, MSI is not obligated to repair the issues or reported defects within a specific duration. MSI may elect to incorporate any repairs into a future update, or not at all, at MSI’s sole discretion. The functionality of the Software depends, in part, on the functionality of other software, hardware, operating systems and services beyond MSI’s control and thus, MSI cannot provide assurance that the Software will work as expected, at any given time.

14. **LIMITATION ON REMEDIES; NO CONSEQUENTIAL OR OTHER DAMAGES.**

Your exclusive remedy for any breach of this Limited Warranty is as set forth below. Except for any refund elected by MSI, YOU ARE NOT ENTITLED TO ANY DAMAGES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, if the Software does not meet MSI’s Limited Warranty, and, to the maximum extent allowed by applicable law, even if any remedy fails of its essential purpose. The terms of Section 17 (“Exclusion of Incidental, Consequential and Certain Other Damages”) are also incorporated into this Limited Warranty. Some states/jurisdictions do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation or exclusion may not apply to you. This Limited Warranty gives you specific legal rights. You may have other rights which vary from state/jurisdiction to state/jurisdiction.

15. **YOUR EXCLUSIVE REMEDY.** MSI's and its suppliers' entire liability and your exclusive remedy for any breach of this Limited Warranty or for any other breach of this EULA or for any other liability relating to the Software shall be, at MSI's option from time to time exercised subject to applicable law, (a) refund of the prorated amount paid (if any) for the Software during the last 12 months, or (b) repair or provide a replacement of the Software, that does not meet this Limited Warranty and that is returned to MSI with a copy of your receipt. If a pro-rated refund is issued, this will immediately revoke your license to the Software. You will receive the remedy elected by MSI without charge by MSI, but you may be charged a separate fee by third parties (e.g. your financial institution). This Limited Warranty is void if failure of the Software has resulted from accident, abuse, misapplication, abnormal use or a virus. If replacement Software is issued, it will have a similar Limited Warranty for 15 days from date of issue; during this time you should fully test for defects and functionality and report any issues back to MSI. MSI will use commercially reasonable efforts to provide your remedy within a commercially reasonable time of your compliance with MSI's warranty remedy procedures. Outside the United States or Canada, neither these remedies nor any product support services offered by MSI are available without proof of purchase from an authorized international source.

16. **DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTIES.** The Limited Warranty that appears above is the only expressed warranty made to you and is provided in lieu of any other expressed warranties or similar obligations (if any) created by any advertising, documentation, packaging, or other communications.

EXCEPT FOR THE LIMITED WARRANTY AND TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW, MSI AND ITS SUPPLIERS PROVIDE THE SOFTWARE AND SUPPORT SERVICES (IF ANY) AS IS AND WITH ALL FAULTS, AND HEREBY DISCLAIM ALL OTHER WARRANTIES AND CONDITIONS, WHETHER EXPRESS, IMPLIED OR STATUTORY, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ANY (IF ANY) IMPLIED WARRANTIES, DUTIES OR CONDITIONS OF MERCHANTABILITY, OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, OF RELIABILITY OR AVAILABILITY, OF ACCURACY OR COMPLETENESS OF RESPONSES, OF RESULTS, OF WORKMANLIKE EFFORT, OF LACK OF VIRUSES, AND OF LACK OF NEGLIGENCE, ALL WITH REGARD TO THE SOFTWARE, AND THE PROVISION OF OR FAILURE TO PROVIDE SUPPORT OR OTHER SERVICES, INFORMATION, SOFTWARE, AND RELATED CONTENT THROUGH THE SOFTWARE OR OTHERWISE ARISING OUT OF THE USE OF THE SOFTWARE. ALSO, THERE IS NO WARRANTY OR CONDITION OF TITLE, QUIET ENJOYMENT, QUIET POSSESSION, CORRESPONDENCE TO DESCRIPTION OR NON-INFRINGEMENT WITH REGARD TO THE SOFTWARE. THE WARRANTY/LIABILITY SHALL BE HELD REGARDLESS OF THE FORM OF THE CLAIM AND WHETHER MSI WAS INFORMED OF FAILURES/DEFECTS/LIABILITIES.

NCSU, WHICH IS THE OWNER OF COPYRIGHTS OR TECHNICAL INFORMATION INCORPORATED INTO, UTILIZED BY, OR SUBSISTING IN THIS LICENSED PRODUCT OR LICENSED SERVICE, MAKES NO WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND. IN

PARTICULAR, THERE ARE NO EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE NOR IS THERE A WARRANTY THAT THE USE OF THIS LICENSED PRODUCT OR LICENSED SERVICE WILL NOT INFRINGE ANY PATENT, COPYRIGHT, TRADEMARK OR OTHER RIGHTS. IN ADDITION, NOTHING IN THIS AGREEMENT MAY BE DEEMED TO BE A REPRESENTATION OR WARRANTY BY NCSU OF THE VALIDITY OF ANY OF THE COPYRIGHTS OR TECHNICAL INFORMATION INCORPORATED INTO, UTILIZED BY, OR SUBSISTING IN THIS LICENSED PRODUCT OR LICENSED SERVICE, OR OF THE ACCURACY, SAFETY, EFFICACY, OR USEFULNESS, FOR ANY PURPOSE, OF THE COPYRIGHTS OR TECHNICAL INFORMATION. NCSU HAS NO OBLIGATION, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, TO SUPERVISE, MONITOR, REVIEW OR OTHERWISE ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE PRODUCTION, MANUFACTURE, TESTING, MARKETING OR SALE OF ANY LICENSED PRODUCT OR LICENSED SERVICE.

17. **EXCLUSION OF INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL AND CERTAIN OTHER DAMAGES.** TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW, IN NO EVENT SHALL MSI OR ITS SUPPLIERS BE LIABLE FOR ANY SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, PUNITIVE, INDIRECT, OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES WHATSOEVER (INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES FOR LOSS OF PROFITS OR CONFIDENTIAL OR OTHER INFORMATION, FOR BUSINESS INTERRUPTION, FOR PERSONAL INJURY, FOR LOSS OF PRIVACY, FOR FAILURE TO MEET ANY DUTY INCLUDING OF GOOD FAITH OR OF REASONABLE CARE, FOR NEGLIGENCE, AND FOR ANY OTHER PECUNIARY OR OTHER LOSS WHATSOEVER) ARISING OUT OF OR IN ANY WAY RELATED TO THE USE OF OR INABILITY TO USE THE SOFTWARE, THE PROVISION OF OR FAILURE TO PROVIDE SUPPORT OR OTHER SERVICES, INFORMATION, SOFTWARE, AND RELATED CONTENT THROUGH THE SOFTWARE OR OTHERWISE ARISING OUT OF THE USE OF THE SOFTWARE, OR OTHERWISE UNDER OR IN CONNECTION WITH ANY PROVISION OF THIS EULA, EVEN IN THE EVENT OF THE FAULT, TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE), MISREPRESENTATION, STRICT LIABILITY, BREACH OF CONTRACT OR BREACH OF WARRANTY OF MSI OR ANY SUPPLIER, AND EVEN IF MSI OR ANY SUPPLIER HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.

18. **LIMITATION OF LIABILITY AND REMEDIES.** NOTWITHSTANDING ANY DAMAGES THAT YOU MIGHT INCUR FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER (INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, ALL DAMAGES REFERENCED HEREIN AND ALL DIRECT OR GENERAL DAMAGES IN CONTRACT OR ANYTHING ELSE), THE ENTIRE LIABILITY OF MSI AND ANY OF ITS SUPPLIERS UNDER ANY PROVISION OF THIS EULA AND YOUR EXCLUSIVE REMEDY HEREUNDER (EXCEPT FOR ANY REMEDY OF REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT ELECTED BY MSI WITH RESPECT TO ANY BREACH OF THE LIMITED WARRANTY) SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE GREATER OF THE ACTUAL DAMAGES YOU INCUR IN REASONABLE RELIANCE ON THE SOFTWARE UP TO THE AMOUNT ACTUALLY PAID BY YOU DURING THE PRECEDING 12 MONTHS FOR THE SOFTWARE OR US\$5.00. THE FOREGOING

LIMITATIONS, EXCLUSIONS AND DISCLAIMERS (INCLUDING SECTIONS 13, 14, 15, 16, AND 17) SHALL APPLY TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW, EVEN IF ANY REMEDY FAILS ITS ESSENTIAL PURPOSE.

19. **LICENSEE INDEMNIFICATION**. Licensee will indemnify, defend and hold harmless NCSU, its trustees, officers, agents and employees (collectively, the "Indemnified Parties"), from and against any and all liability, loss, damage, action, claim or expense suffered or incurred by the Indemnified Parties which results from or arises out of third party claims in connection with (individually, a "Liability" and collectively, the "Liabilities") breach by Licensee of any duty, covenant or agreement contained in this EULA or a lawsuit, action, or claim brought by any third party that includes any allegation which, if proven true, would constitute a breach by Licensee of any duty, covenant or agreement contained in this Agreement.

The Indemnified Party shall promptly notify Licensee of any claim or action giving rise to a Liability subject to the provisions of Article 19. Licensee shall have the duty to defend any such claim or action, at its cost and expense. Indemnified Party must have the right, however, to approve counsel through NCSU and through its governing board to represent it, and such approval will not be unreasonably withheld. In the event Licensee or any of its parents, affiliates or subsidiaries is also named in a particular claim, Licensee may choose the same attorneys who defend the Indemnified Parties to defend Licensee unless there arises a conflict of interest between the Licensee and one or more of the Indemnified Parties or among the Indemnified Parties. The indemnification rights of NCSU or other Indemnified Party contained herein are in addition to all other rights which such Indemnified Party may have at law or in equity or otherwise.

20. **USE OF NCSU'S NAME, LOGOS AND TRADEMARKS** You agree that you will not, nor permit end-users to:

- (a) use the name, logos or trademarks of NCSU in any publication, advertising, publicity, press release, promotional activity or otherwise, any trade-name, personal name, trademark, trade device, service mark, symbol, image, icon, or any abbreviation, contraction or simulation thereof owned by the other party or owned by the other party; or
- (b) use the name or image of any employee or agent of NCSU in any publication, publicity, advertising, press release, promotional activity or otherwise; or
- (c) represent, either directly or indirectly, that any product or service of NCSU is your product or service or that it is made in accordance with or utilizes the information or documents of NCSU.

21. **RESERVATION OF RIGHTS** NCSU retains the right, on behalf of themselves and all other non-profit academic or governmental research institutions in the United States, to use the Original Software for non-commercial research purposes, including sponsored research and collaborations, and/or the subject matter described and claimed

in Copyrights or Technical Information that pertain to NCSU. As used herein, the term “non-commercial research purposes” means the use of Copyrights or Technical Information for academic research or other not-for-profit or scholarly purposes which are undertaken at a non-profit or governmental institution that does not use Copyrights or Technical Information in the production or manufacture of products for sale or the performance of services for a fee.

22. **APPLICABLE LAW.** If you acquired this Software in the United States, this EULA is governed by the laws of the State of North Carolina. If you acquired this Software in Canada, unless expressly prohibited by local law, this EULA is governed by the laws in force in the Province of Ontario, Canada; and, in respect of any dispute which may arise hereunder, you consent to the jurisdiction of the federal and provincial courts sitting in Toronto, Ontario. If you acquired this Software in the European Union, Iceland, Norway, or Switzerland, then local law applies. If you acquired this Software in any other country, then local law may apply.

23. **ENTIRE AGREEMENT; SEVERABILITY.** This EULA (including any addendum or amendment to this EULA which is included with the Software) are the entire agreement between you and MSI relating to the Software and the support services (if any) and they supersede all prior or contemporaneous oral or written communications, proposals and representations with respect to the Software or any other subject matter covered by this EULA. To the extent the terms of any MSI policies or programs for support services conflict with the terms of this EULA, the terms of this EULA shall control. If any provision of this EULA is held to be void, invalid, unenforceable or illegal, the other provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
